Tribal-arts dealer Kevin Conru has written several books. His latest, *Solomon Islands Art: The Conru Collection* (5 Continents, £60) is available through Amazon (www.amazon.co.uk). The book presents his own collection of art from these islands: a broad assortment of images, weapons, body ornaments and other artefacts from the eighteenth to the early twentieth century.

2 SPECIALIST: **MOUNT-MAKER**

Colin Bowles (020-7498 6311), who made the stands for many of Kevin's masks, is mount-maker to the Queen, and works for museums all over the world. As well as restoring works of art, he makes all types of supports for their display. 'We do all the bits and pieces you don't really see,' says Colin. 'In fact, if we've done our job properly, you often wouldn't know we've done it.' To mount a mask on a patinated brass stand, like Kevin's, would cost £200 or more.

3 IDENTIFIED: **STONE**

Kevin and Anna's smart kitchen countertops combine oak with honed Belgian bluestone, which costs £98 per square metre from Stone Age (020-7384 9090; www.estone.co.uk).

4 SOURCE: **BED**

Anna bought their bed in Brussels. Closer to home, try The Original Bedstead Company (01536-407138; www.obc-uk.net). Its 'Lerwick' bed, in antique nickel, costs from £1,199 for the complete bedstead □
